

On 24th Feb 2022, an E – SHRAM CARD campaign was organised at Samudaya bhavana at Myalapanahalli village



Workers were excited about the campaign and registration, as the team provided for on-the spot free-of- cost registration, which otherwise amounts to not less than Rs 250 at various centres doing registration.

On the request of the villagers and Zilla panchyath member the Campaign was extended on 27^{th} Feb 2022 Sunday. Totally around 150 E – SHRAM Cards are done through this campaign among the villagers.

The e-Shram portal provides all the registered workers an e-Shram card containing a 12-digit UAN (Universal Account Number), and they can access benefits of government schemes even if they are working outside the state. E-Shram portal is indeed a significant step towards registering unorganised workers including construction labourers, migrant workers, street vendors and domestic workers, gig and platform workers, etc.

The initiative is considered as a major effort on the part of the government to recognise more than 40 core unorganised sector workers in the country and also the event was appreciated by PDO of Singanayakanahalli Gram panchyath. Program went on well we thank the gram panchyath officials and our principal for providing this opportunity to do their yeomen service.


Report on "A Selfie with Sapling Campaign"


The NSS volunteers had participated with great zeal and enthusiasm to observe the "World Environment Day" on 5th June, 2021.



Report on "Saplings Distribution"


