During the academic year around ninety (90) programs were organised by various Forums, Committees and Cells.

The department of commerce introduced the **Nitte Premier League Cricket** tournament season-one was in 16 teams participated. The NPL witnessed teamwork, a spirit of joy and healthy competition.

Various Committees and Cells conducted events for the students and undertook outreach programs. Outreach programs are arranged by the community orientation club and the eco- club. The **Sanchari library** is an initiative that extends library and reading facilities to the public.

The student council is active and have successfully undertaken the **Advitya 2.0**, a three-day intra-college festival, with the theme 'Innovate, Elevate, Achieve,' featuring a friendly competition among five teams - Eagles, Sharks, Panthers, Dragons, and Bulls. On the first day Sports events were organised, on the second day events related to Commerce, Management, Technology, and Language and on the third day cultural programs were held. The Fest is aimed at fostering a competitive spirit and teamwork among the students. The NCC unit is well functioning.
