Guest Lecture Report on Redemption of Debentures



On June 25th 2024, a guest lecture on the topic "Redemption of Debentures" was held at Master Hirannaiah Auditorium, 3rd Floor The session was conducted by Prof. Geetha R, who is a renowned expert in the field of finance and accounting. The event was organized by Department of commerce, aimed at providing students with in-depth knowledge and practical insights into the process and significance of debenture redemption.

The lecture began with a brief overview of debentures, explaining them as long-term financial instruments issued by companies to borrow funds. The speaker highlighted different types of debentures, such as: Convertible and Non-Convertible Debentures, Secured and Unsecured Debentures, Redeemable and Irredeemable Debentures, Importance of Debenture Redemption

The significance of debenture redemption in a company's financial strategy was discussed. The speaker emphasized that timely redemption of debentures helps in: Maintaining the company's creditworthiness, managing debt levels effectively, Ensuring investor confidence

Various methods of debenture redemption were detailed, including: Lump-Sum Payment: Redemption of debentures at the end of the maturity period. Instalment Payment: Redemption through periodic payments over the term of the debentures. Purchase in Open Market:

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Company buys back debentures from the open market before maturity. Sinking Fund Method: A fund set aside periodically to ensure redemption of debentures.


The speaker provided a comprehensive guide on the accounting treatment of debenture redemption. Key points included: Journal Entries: Recording the redemption of debentures, payment of interest, and any gain or loss on redemption. Amortization of Discount or Premium on Issue of Debentures: Systematic write-off of discount or premium over the term of the debentures. Provision for Debenture Redemption Reserve (DRR): Legal requirement to create a reserve for ensuring debenture redemption.


